**Brett Friedlander** is a native of Atlanta and a graduate of the University of South Carolina who has written about sports since 1981 for the *Beaufort Gazette*, the *Annapolis Capital*, and the *Fayetteville Observer*. Brett has covered the Final Four, the Masters, the Super Bowl, and the World Series, winning 24 national, state, and regional awards for his work. He is currently a columnist for the *Wilmington Star-News* and lives in Fayetteville, North Carolina, with his family. *Chasing Moonlight* is his first book.

**Robert “Bob” Reising** has degrees from Michigan State University, the University of Connecticut, and Duke University.
