About James and Suzanne Gindlesperger

Authors of *So You Think You Know Gettysburg?*
*The Stories Behind the Monuments and the
Men Who Fought One of America's Most Epic Battles*

Husband-and-wife team James and Suzanne Gindlesperger share a passion for writing, photography, and, of course, the Civil War. Over the past 20 years, they have visited the Gettysburg National Military Park nearly 100 times. Their many visits led them to create their latest book, *So You Think You Know Gettysburg?*

The couple met on a blind date arranged by Suzanne's brother-in-law while James was an engineer with a Pittsburgh chemical company and Suzanne worked as a secretary with a steel company in Johnstown. In 2010, they celebrated their 40th wedding anniversary.

James is the author of three previous Civil War books: *Escape from Libby Prison* and *Fire on the Water*, both of which won the George Washington Honor Medal from the Freedoms Foundation, and *Seed Corn of the Confederacy*. *Escape from Libby Prison* was also featured in a 1998 Discovery Channel documentary entitled *Breakout: POWs*. James presents lectures on the Civil War throughout the East and has collaborated on Civil War projects with National Geographic and NASA, among others.

Suzanne is a cofounder of Pennwriters, a professional organization for published and aspiring authors, and has chaired many literary committees for the organization. *So You Think You Know Gettysburg?* is her first book, although she assisted her husband in researching his previous publications.

James and Suzanne Gindlesperger are members of the Friends of Gettysburg Foundation, the National Trust for Historic Preservation, and the Civil War Preservation Trust. The couple live in Johnstown, Pennsylvania, with their two dogs.
